DO YOU HAVE AN ARREST RECORD?

Arrest records can keep you from gaining employment, renting a place to live, and can create many other problems.

Don't miss this opportunity to have your arrest record sealed or expunged from public view.

The Broward State Attorney's Office in partnership with the Broward County Clerk of Courts, Broward Sheriff's Office, Mayor Wayne Messam of the City of Miramar, and the Miramar Police Department is hosting a Sealing and Expungement Workshop on Thursday, March 3, 2022 from 3 pm to 7 pm.

If you were charged with a crime in Broward County and the case did not result in a conviction, you may be eligible to have a single arrest record expunged.

If you were charged with a crime in Broward County and you received an adjudication withheld, that case may be eligible to be sealed.

Only cases that occurred in Broward County are eligible for review.

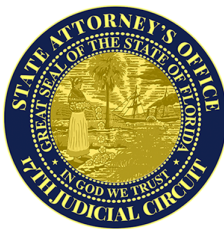
